Course Title: Cooperative Education: Culinary

Course Description :

Provides supervised, on-the-job training in selected business, industrial, or service firms coordinated by the college. Prerequisite: Program head approval is required for enrollment in this course. Laboratory 15 hours per week. 3 credits

General Course Purpose:

The general goal is to prepare students for actual employment in their chosen professions by enabling them to practice principles and skills learned during prior classroom instruction and to observe and participate in actual situations occurring in the field.

Course Prerequisites/Corequisites:

Prerequisite: Program head approval is required for enrollment in this course.

Upon completing the course, the student will be able to:

- x Demonstrate skills requisite for providing hospitality services in a hotel, food service establishment, or institution;
