Course Prefix and Number: OPT 280 **Credits:** 4

Course Title: Contact Lens III

Course Description:

Promotes the proficiency of clinical skills in fundamental contact lens tasks at the entry level with an emphasis on professional standards. Specialty contact lenses are introduced. Includes state and national certification exam review. Part III of III. Prerequisite: OPT 274 or equivalent. Lecture 2 hours per week and laboratory 4 hours per week.

General Course Purpose:

A capstone course that provides students with the theoretical knowledge and practical hands-on applications of contact lens fitting to enable them to function as effective opticians.

Prerequisite: OPT 274 or equivalent
